## Beavertown Borough Council met on September 13th, 2022

**GUESTS ON AGENDA:** Tim Wagner. Jim Emery (CK COG). Jim reviewed sidewalk specs. Jim also had CK COG's new fees for Residential Rentals, the collection of fees and a Resolution.

Executive Session was called at 7:17 P.M.

Council came out of Executive Session at 7:36 P.M., no action taken.

**MINUTES, BILLS & TREASURER'S REPORT:** Lucas motioned to approve August 2022, minutes; Brian second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Will motioned to approve the bills; Denny second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Brian motioned to approve the treasurer's report; Linda second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Grant money filing was discussed. Kern St./Luphers Run bridge, still waiting on DEP, for epermit. Fireproof file/box (tabled). Sidewalks: waiting for the specifications to be finalized. Advertising again for a part time employee. Jake brake signs have not been installed. CK COG will help with getting an occupancy permit. \$5,000.00 from General Fund has been transferred to the Liquid CD. Brian Haight will be contacted about trucks entering N. Sassafras St. Children at Play signs on Sassafras was discussed, no action taken. The Library Committee will be holding their book sale on November 12, 2022.

**ATTORNEY'S REPORT:** The Peddlers Ordinance No.2022-02; Lucas motioned to in act the Peddlers Ordinance No. 2022-02; Will second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. The specification for sidewalks is not completed, it will be updated with CK COG specs. The ad for a new furnace has been placed, twice.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** The Mayor reviewed old, new, and vacant properties, building permits, rental properties, residents' concerns, fire co. and ambulance, the police report and during COVID the Revitalization Committee had disband; they will be starting back up in the fall. The Rental permit fee & Resolution from CK COG is tabled for November meeting. The fire co and ambulance have exhausted the General Fund budgeted amount of \$2,500.00 for 2022; Will motion that a letter will be sent to both, fire co and ambulance, stating that they have exhausted the 2022 budget amount for fuel reimbursement with a final check for 2022 fuel reimbursement; Brian second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. The stop sign, no parking sign and flowerpot that was hit by a car @ Market St & Center St, expenses will be turned into drivers' insurance.

**BOROUGH SUPERVISOR'S REPORT:** The playground has been mulched and stone put at walkway & bike rack. The brush on the bank on Sassafras St has been cleared. Anti-skid has been delivered; cold patch work has been done. Clean out more inlet boxes. Chris will get costs for sealing cracks on roads.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Deposits: General Fund-EIT \$12,738.90, Real Estate Tax \$92.51, Delinquent Real Estate Tax \$10.25, Delinquent Per Capita \$11.00, Realty Transfer \$1,837.50, Insurance dividend \$92.53; Total \$14,782.69. Payroll-reimbursement from Church's Acct. for late filing fee to PSAB-UC \$50.00; Total \$50.00. LST-LST \$1,771.89, Fines \$163.33; Total \$1,935.22. Liquid CD – transfer from General fund \$5,000.00; Total \$5,000.00. David Hassinger would like to donate a Christmas tree this year; Linda will follow up David. The Vesta Coleman room has green chairs and broken tables that the Girls Scouts would like to know if they can be removed; tabled for October.

**NEW BUISNESS:** Denny motioned to approve Trick or Treat night for Monday, October 31, 2022, from 6 p.m. – 8 p.m.; Linda second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Rick motioned to advertise Trick or Treat night for Monday, October 31, 2022, from 6 p.m. – 8 p.m. and the October curfew; Will second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried.
