July 9, 2019

Beavertown Borough Council met on Tuesday, July 9, 2019

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

GUESTS: Robin Kauffman, Officer Shaffer, Ken Boonie. Robin reported that the Revitalization Committee would be holding a homemade ice cream contest on July 21, 2019 starting at 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. and they also have a survey on line that they would like residents to take.

MINUTES, BILLS and TREASURERS REPORT: Denny motioned to approve the minutes; Will second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Will motioned to approve the bills; Ron second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Lori motioned to approve the bills with changes to the Meckleys invoice for 2019 road repairs to be \$40,000.00 paid out of Liquid Fuels and \$46,893.67 from the General Fund; Linda second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Lori motioned to approve treasurer's report; Ron second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Donation to the Union Cemetery Association was again discussed; Linda motioned to approve a \$1,00.00 donation to the Union Cemetery Association; Ron second, with a roll call vote – Will abstained, Linda yes, Ron yes, Denny yes, Lori yes; with a 1-abstained vote and 4 – yes votes-motion carried.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT: The Borough is in the running for the CDBG grant money, for sidewalks.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor reviewed properties, residents' concerns and the police report. He received the parade permit. The food drive has been going very well. Mayor Hollenbach stated that he will be out of town at a conference on July 18 – 21, 2019 and from July 28 – August 4, 2019.

BOROUGH SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: The new rain gutters and downspouts, on the Borough Bldg. will be installed on Monday, July 15, 2019. Phil also reminded the Council of the special election to be held on August 4, 2019.
