July 13, 2021

Beavertown Borough Council met on July 13, 2021

ATTENDANCE: Lori Foor (President), Will Kepner, Linda Snook, Brian Wood, Ron Plumber, Denny Mallonee, Mayor Hollenbach, Bob Cravitz (Solicitor), Philip Walter (Borough Supervisor).

Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

GUESTS: Lana Steimling and Zane Bilger. Lana asked Council what could be done with the feral cats, coming from the Pheasant property, which she believes to be ill. She was given a complaint form, from the Mayor. She said she would fill it out and bring it back to the Borough Office on Thursday.

MINUTES, BILLS and TREASURERS REPORT: Will motioned to approve the minutes; Brian second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Brian motioned to approve the bills; Denny second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Lori motioned to approve treasurer's report; Linda second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes – motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: None.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT: None.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor reviewed properties, residents' concerns and the police report. The County Block Grant was approved. Denny motioned for the grant monies to be used for storm water projects; Ron second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes – motion carried. Melody Folk donated the flowers on the corners of Market and Center Sts. Mayor will talk to Weikel's Busing about changing the bus stop at the Hahn Development; this could lessen the chance of an accident and also the parking issue at the current bus stop.

BOROUGH SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: Phil has all of the no parking signs, post and accessories needed to do the no parking areas; he will have to rent a core drill, to drill holes in the sidewalks for the posts. The 2021 paving project has started. Boop's will be down to weld the furnace, towards the end of this month. There is a problem with getting trucks to deliver more mulch; Phil may have to haul the mulch.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Deposits: General Fund – EIT \$4,821.91, Real Estate Tax \$732.25, Delinquent Real Estate \$211.43, BMA Sewer (reimbursement of health ins. \$231.75, BMA Water (reimbursement of health ins. \$231.75, Beaver Township reimbursement for workers comp \$1,377.50; Total \$7,606.59. LST Fund - LST \$309.71, Fines \$209.97; Total \$519.68. Payroll-Borough 5,000.00, BMA Sewer \$3,383.56, BMA Water \$2,755.15; Total \$11,138.71.

NEW BUSINESS: Because of Melissa Plumber's current job, she cannot run for Tax Collector, so she will be withdrawing from the election; Beavertown also needs a Constable. A resident telephoned the Borough Office and asked about a handicap parking space; there is no ordinance in Beavertown for handicap parking spaces. Pat will contact the resident and advise her of that.
